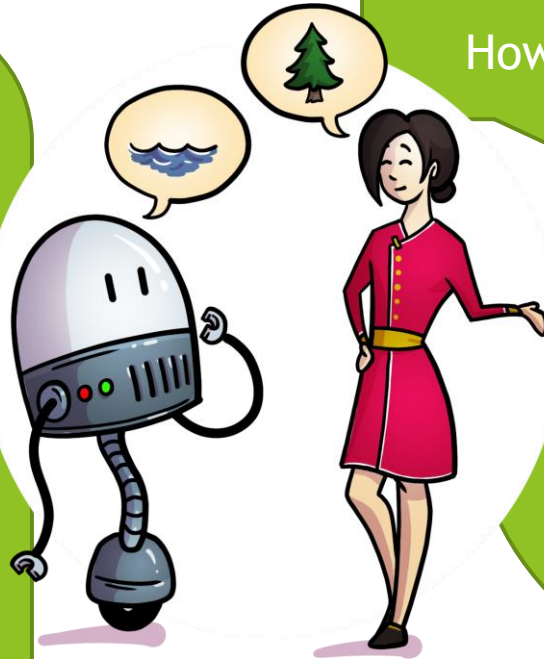


Should robots look after the elderly?
